The huge spider silently crept across its silvery web.

Each word in this sentence
does a job. It belongs to a
WORD CLASS.

ADJECTIVES

The **huge** spider silently crept across its **silvery** web.

The words highlighted in
green are **ADJECTIVES**.

You are learning about... **ADJECTIVES** and **DETERMINERS**

An **adjective** describes a **noun**

These adjectives
describe the noun *beard*

The wizard's **beard** was **long** and **grey**.

This adjective describes
the noun *door*

These adjectives describe the
noun *path*

The **mysterious** **door** opened onto a **long** and **narrow** **path**.

There are many types of **adjective**
Here are some examples

Adjectives of size and shape	Adjectives of colour
an enormous statue a miniscule pencil a triangular prism	a silvery moon the pale horse a crimson scarf
Adjectives of character	Adjectives of material
the wise, old woman an intelligent bird a loyal friend	rough skin rugged countryside a sharp blade

You are learning about... **ADJECTIVES** and **DETERMINERS**

When **adjectives** are part of a list,
commas are used.

A **small, bulky, brown** box.

Her **large, almond shaped, pale, blue** eyes blinked with
surprise.

You are learning about... **ADJECTIVES** and **DETERMINERS**

DETERMINERS

Each soldier took **four** steps to the right.

The words highlighted in
blue are **DETERMINERS**.

You are learning about... **ADJECTIVES** and **DETERMINERS**

A **determiner** describes a **noun**.

This determiner describes
the noun *parents*

This determiner describes
the noun *night*

Both **parents** read to their children **every** **night**.

This determiner describes
the noun *children*

This determiner describes
the noun *sweet*

All the **children** have at least **one** **sweet**.

Determiners of quantity	Determiners of number
any apples few excuses several computers some pens enough water	one piece of cake second place a previous winner
