Key Stage 2 Assessment Results

This table shows the percentage of children at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) who achieved the **expected standard or above** in reading, writing, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and maths. It compares Batheaston's results with the national average.

This table shows the percentage of children at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) who achieved a **higher level of attainment** in reading, writing, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and maths. It compares Batheaston's results with the national average.

Percentage of children achieving a higher level standard (Greater Depth) 2017

Reading	41%	25%
Writing	22%	18%
Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar	48%	31%
Maths	33%	23%
Reading, writing and maths combined	11%	9%

This table shows the **average progress** children made during their time at Batheaston. Progress is typically measured from Year 2 (the end of Key Stage 1) to Year 6 (the end of Key Stage 2). The 2017 data is based around 0.

Reading	1.7
Writing	0.3
Maths	2.0

This table shows the **average scaled score** in the 2017 reading, SPAG and maths tests. A pupil's 'raw score' is converted into a 'scaled score'; 80 is the lowest scaled score that can be awarded and 120 is the highest. A pupil awarded a scaled score of 100 or more has met the expected standard in each test.
