Work on the decking has been completed and now we are sending requests for any un-needed items from your homes and gardens to help us fill the learning space ready for use. Please have a look at this list and let me know if you would be able to donate items towards this exciting project.

- Old tyres that can be developed into a sensory garden
- Aggregate of any kind – pebbles, small stones, gravel to fill the tyres.
- Rope of any length and thickness
- Salt bins or other plastic bins to store resources
- Natural materials – pine cones, conkers, pebbles, driftwood, shells etc
- Plastic piping and connectors
- Metal pots, pans, mugs for a muddy kitchen as well as wooden/metal utensils
- Small plants or seeds to grow
- Nuts and bolts of any size
- Plastic or wooden crates
- Large pieces of fabric
- Planks of wood, small logs, large logs, log slices of any size, bamboo canes
- wooden shelving storage to put in the shed.
- Small storage boxes or wicker baskets
- Wooden pallets
- Ribbon and string
- Blackboard paint
- Buckets
- Plastic small world animals/creatures
- Plastic measuring equipment – measuring jugs, cartons etc.
- Rope reels
