## Key Stage 2 Assessment Results 2016

Please note that the content, format and scoring of tests changed in 2016. Comparisons with previous years cannot be made reliably.

This table shows the percentage of children at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) who achieved the **expected standard or above** in reading, writing, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and maths. It compares Batheaston's results with the national average.

This table shows the **average progress** children made during their time at Batheaston. Progress is typically measured from Year 2 (the end of Key Stage 1) to Year 6 (the end of Key Stage 2). The 2014 and 2015 data is based around 100. The 2016 data is based around 0.

This table shows the **average scaled score** in the 2016 reading, SPAG and maths tests. This year, the tests were scored in a different way. A pupil's 'raw score' was converted into a 'scaled score'; 80 is the lowest scaled score that can be awarded and 120 is the highest. A pupil awarded a scaled score of 100 or more has met the expected standard in each test.
